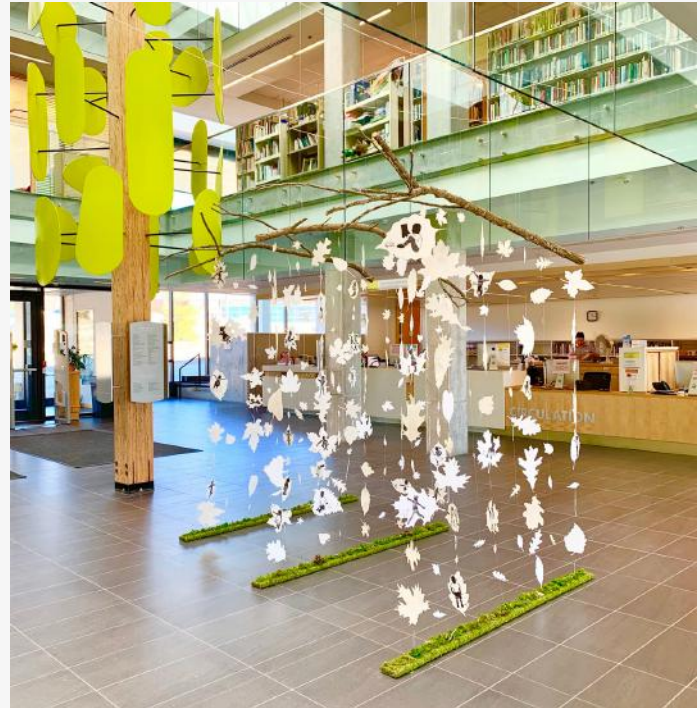

We are very pleased to announce that on December 10, 2019 we will launch a different Integrated Library System Platform (LSP). This is a collaborative initiative amongst 14 Ontario academic libraries. This means the catalogue searching features will look different and much fresher.

## RESERVES

The Reserve and Short Loans service allows us to circulate Library materials in high demand for shorter than normal loan periods. Requests may be submitted in person, online, or via email. Forms are available at the Circulation Desk or online **at this link**.

Any item in the circulating collection can be placed on Reserve. You have a choice of a 3 hour Reserve or a 2 Day Short Loan (Held at the Circulation Desk). Examples of 3 hour reserves are photocopies of a journal article (maximum of 3 copies), up to 10% of any other copyrighted material itself not owned by the Library, or a faculty member's personal copy of a book (at his/her own risk). Government documents and course packs are excluded.
